Additionally, Buck Services is an active participant in industry organizations, trade associations, and local chambers. Serving Our Community

Eighty-seven percent of Buck Services' clients are institutions rooted in providing for their communities. We maintain relationships with schools, religious institutions, community centers, public event locations, local government offices, park districts, and medical centers. It is Buck Services' goal to aid societies' institutions in reaching the best of their potential, helping to utilize and manage their facilities efficiently, cost-effectively, and in ways that maximize each facility's possibilities allowing them to have a positive effect on their surrounding communities. In response to the pandemic, 260+ members of Team Buck sanitized and disinfected more than 5 million square feet. First responder facilities such as firehouses, police stations, and medical care sites were among top priority. Much of these services were donated. Additionally, Team Buck was specially trained to disinfect all 265 DuPage County voting sites during the 2020 Federal Election. Buck Services worked with the DuPage County election board to create a program that would allow people to feel safe about the voting process. We took the initiative to manufacture and distribute face masks to Chicago-land communities in need, resulting to this day in the production and donation of over 2500+ PPE pieces. Crain's awarded Buck Services for our efforts with the 2021 Notable Healthcare Hero Award. It is an inherent part of our mission to invest in community development. We donate both monetarily and labor-based to those with the same mission, including but not limited to the Diocese of Joliet Catholic Education Foundation, Special Olympics, DuPage PADS, Loaves and Fishes, Guardian Angel Community Services, and Neighborhood Food Pantries. Buck Services also looks to support local families. With involvement in the Youth Development Program at West Chicago Community High School and the West Chicago Community High School Education Foundation, we aided in creating a Work/Study program. Buck Services was chosen to receive the Enduring Spirit Award from the Western DuPage Chamber of Commerce. This award was in recognition of involvement in the community, while recognizing sustained charitable contributions. In 2021, St. Francis High School honored Buck Services the St. Francis Society designation award for philanthropic activities.

Caring About Conditions

Beginning in 2020 and expanding throughout 2021, Buck Services enrolled and completed the GBAC-Trained Technician Program. This program trains professionals to recognize and respond accordingly in a safe and effective manner to the challenges presented not only by COVID-19, but a myriad of other infectious diseases. It is designed to prepare for, respond to and recover from biohazards in the workplace. In 2021, Buck Services received the Clorox Total 360 Award for investment in the pandemic related effects on society. In 2010, Buck Services and St. Francis High School in Wheaton, Illinois were recognized as partners in a LEED certified facility - which, at the time, was only the second high school to be recognized as such in the State of Illinois. We offer rustom recycling programs to many facilities which previously had none and aid out-of-date facilities in the education and follow-thru of practices modernized to keep our environments safe, inclusive of asbestos detection and removal. We offer full-service Green Cleaning programs and have made a significant investment in sustainable equipment. Buck Services utilizes industry specific machinery which saves on water and electricity consumption. We recognize the role each one of us plays in maintaining facilities which affect our environmental impact and do our best to ensure a healthy atmosphere for your patrons and the planet alike.
